Following eight years banging heads together at Taylor Wimpey (TW) we have been advised that the legal's between TW and the Petersfield Town Council (PTC) are now completed and our Green Spaces & Playground have now been formally adopted by the PTC.

You may remember TW were planning to hand over our community spaces to a Glasgow company who informed us they would only cut our grass and we, the residents would have to pay for any additional maintenance to shrubs, hedges or trees.

Good news indeed after our lengthy battle with TW and our thanks to the PTC for their support. We now wait for our roads, footpaths and lighting to be adopted by HCC, but this is on hold due to Covid-19. Likewise, the adoption of Skinners Farm Lane by the PTC.

VE Day Friday 8th May:

Those old enough may recollect their parents talking about Victory in Europe Day on May 8th 1945 when the country celebrated the end of the war in

Europe and remembered those who gave their lives for their country, our Allies and those on the Home Front.

The Town Council have a full programme of events planned to remember this auspicious day 75 years ago with commemorative services in The Town plus celebrations but Covid-19 means most of the plans have been cancelled. However, in collaboration with Churchers College the PTC will be recording some footage of some of the events that should have taken place and in due course a film of those events that can still be held will be available for viewing. The formal launch of the initial footage will be on Friday 8th May through various mediums. Viewing details will follow.

In the meantime your Residents Association will be erecting bunting on the trees in Barentin Way as our way to remember VE Day celebrations 75 years ago and to pay tribute to those who gave their lives for our freedom.
