Benches on the Kickabout area:

Thanks to funding secured from East Hampshire District Council, the Residents Association has purchased a bench which has been installed on the Kickabout area, with possibly a second to follow.

Fruit Tree Planting on the Kickabout area:

We are fortunate on Ramshill to live on an estate with large areas of open spaces, trees and shrubs and its very own playground. Notwithstanding the RRA has had plans for some years to expand the tree cover in line with local authority and national tree policies.

As a result (and thanks again to a grant from EHDC) a number of fruit trees have been planted on the southwest corner of the Kickabout and further planting is planned for this autumn. In a few years we hope residents can enjoy our very own crop of healthy fruit.

Skinners Farm Lane:

With nights getting darker, a number of residents contacted us saying the lights in Skinners Farm Lane (SFL) were masked by overgrown tree branches. We contacted the Town Council and the trees have been cut back making this essential footpath feel safer for residents.

You may remember there were lengthy discussions concerning the ownership and future maintenance of SFL. These negotiations were satisfactorily completed, and the Town Council has now formally adopted SFL.

Playground:

If you have taken your children to our playground recently, you will have seen the much-improved metal fencing replacing the timber version installed over 20 years ago, and our thanks to the Town Council and our local Councillors for organising this.

Neighbourhood Watch:

Crime figures in Petersfield indicate that vehicle crimes and shed/garage break-ins are on the rise. Be mindful to securely lock garages and sheds, particularly those used for cycles, and get tamperproof screws fitted to all car registration plates.

AGM 2023:

We plan to again hold our next AGM in May when the evenings are lighter and warmer, details nearer the time.
